2 29-11-2024 The petitioners have filed this writ petition with a prayer to set aside the Memo No. 479, dated 28.08.2018, issued by the C.D.P.O., Khanpur, Samastipur and Memo No. 769, dated 18.08.2018, issued by the C.D.P.O., Shivajinagar, Samastipur whereby selection of petitioner nos. 1 and 2 as Anganwari Sewika has been cancelled, with a further prayer to



allow the petitioners to work as Anganwari Sewika for the respective centres of their selection.

2. Learned Advocate for the petitioners submits that this writ petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file an appeal before the appropriate authority as may be permitted under the law.
