APP for the State.

The instant application for regular bail has been filed by the petitioner in connection with Bettiah Mufassil P.S. Case. 401 of 2022 instituted for the offence punishable under Sections 342, 353, 307 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-b)a and 26 of the Arms Act.

Earlier the application for regular bail of the petitioner was rejected by this Court vide order dated 07.02.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 52769 of 2022.

In compliance of the order dated 13.03.2024, a status report has been received dated 21.03.2024 by which it appears that trial will be concluded within a period of ten months.



No fresh ground is made out for reconsideration of the regular bail application of the petitioner, as such, his prayer is rejected.

Accordingly, the application stands disposed off.

The trial Court is directed to conclude the trial within a period of six months failing which the petitioner will be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail.
