5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners were not arrested from the spot, as such, nothing was recovered from their conscious possession and they are neither the



owner nor the driver of the pick-up van and they came to be implicated by the local people but then the name of the person who disclosed the name of the petitioners is not disclosed in the FIR which casts as aspersion on the case of the prosecution. It is further submitted that it appears that the police got the petitioners implicated because of their antecedent through the local people.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

7. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petitioners above-named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Bakhri P.S. Case No. 405 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
