seeking the following relief:-

*"i) for issuance of an appropriate writ
in the nature of Mandamus to command the
respondents for removing the encroachment
over the government land as public Road has
been encroached by respondent no 5 & 6 who
are creating nuisance by way of construction
of hut over the government land which is
contained in Annexure P/1. Consequences
Right to way has been obstructed."*
