APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has renewed his prayer for grant of regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 448 and 324 of the Indian Penal Code, which was earlier rejected vide order dated 11.4.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 46844 of 2022 with a direction to trial court to expedite and conclude the trial.

4. In compliance of order dated 13.03.2024, a progress report dated 22.03.2024 sent by Addl. Distt. & Sessions Judge-XI, Darbhanga has been received which suggests that trial is likely to be concluded in four months.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no hope to conclude the trial in near future. He further



submits that petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 04.05.2022.

6. There is no new ground to reconsider the bail prayer of the petitioner. Hence, this application stands disposed off.

7. The learned trial court is directed to conclude the trial within a period of four months positively, failing which, the petitioner will be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail.
