1. Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf

of the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor
appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The accused/petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

and apprehending her arrest in connection with Sour
Bazar P.S. Case No. 434 of 2023 registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 354
B, 379, 447, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The allegation against the petitioner is to

assault informant alongwith other co-accused
persons/family members causing head and other bodily
injuries, having intention to cause their death, where



occurrence arises out of neighborhood disputes and differences.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that allegation of physical assault is available against husband of petitioner, whereas allegation against petitioner is only to drag informant by holding her hair. It is also submitted that present occurrence arises out of neighborhood differences. While concluding the argument it is submitted that petitioner is a lady of clean antecedent.

5. Learned APP appearing on behalf of the State, opposes the prayer for bail.

6. In view of the facts and circumstances as mentioned above and by taking note of the fact as petitioner is a lady of clean antecedent, accordingly the petitioner above named, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned Court within a period of four weeks, is directed to be released on bail, furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each



with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Saharsa/concerned Court where the case is pending in connection with Sour Bazar P.S. Case No. 434 of 2023 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
