3 27-08-2024 The only contention taken in the instant appeal was

that the grand-father of the appellant who suddenly fell down

and died on 29.04.2015, was actually the victim of a tremor.

2. The postmortem report clearly revealed that the

appellant's grand-father died of cardiac arrest. The inquiry

conducted by the District Administration also was clear, insofar

as there having been no tremor on 29.04.2015 on which date the

grand-father of the appellant died. The tremor was on



26.04.2015.

3. We find absolutely no reason to interfere with the judgment of the learned Single Judge.

4. The appeal stands dismissed.
