2 13-05-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief:-

“1. That this is application on behalf of the
petitioner for issuance of writ in the nature of
mandamus for giving direction to Respondent
No. 2 to dispose off the Armed License Case No.
IX 358/2022 of the petitioner, pending before
him.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks
a direction upon the Respondent No. 2, i.e. the District
Magistrate, Patna, to dispose off his pending application, filed in
the year, 2022, for grant of arms licence.

3. *Per contra*, the learned counsel for the Respondent-State
submits that in case, the petitioner has filed an application for



grant of arms license and the same is still pending, it shall be disposed off, within a fixed time frame.

4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to direct the Respondent No. 2 to dispose off the aforesaid application, filed by the petitioner, for grant of arms license, in case the same is till pending, by passing a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks of receipt / production of a copy of this order.

5. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
