learned APP appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Suryapura P.S. Case No.265 of 2023 registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 8/20/22(c) of the N.D.P.S. Act.

3. The recovery is of 22 kgs of *ganja* from the
house of one Rakesh Kumar Choudhary. The name of the
petitioner has come in the confessional statement of co-accused.
The petitioner is in custody since 03.12.2023.

4. Considering the fact that the petitioner is a
lady and has clean antecedent, this application is allowed.

5. Let the petitioner, above named, be released
on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand)



with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned District & Sessions Judge, Rohtas, in connection with Suryapura P.S. Case No.265 of 2023.

6. This is also subject to the condition that the petitioner shall mark her presence in Natwar Police Station, District- Rohtas on first and third Sunday of every month. Any default in appearance at the Police Station would result in cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioner.
