2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Sarsi P.S. Case No. 239 of 2022 registered for the offences
under Sections 217, 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120(B), 166 and
34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
instant case. Further submission is that prior to the institution of
this case on 23.07.2018 the petitioner had resigned from her
