addressed to dated 30.11.2021 Central the Information Commissioner with a copy to the petitioner whereby it has been communicated that the "Appointing Authority had not considered him for appointment in the Bank as he was not found suitable for the Post." And further for commanding the Respondents to appoint the petitioner on Officer Middle Management Grade- II (Manager) in the light of his selection by the Institute of Banking Personnel Selection and Offer Letter No. Ref. 379/316/12/ Unreserved/208 dated 15.03.2018 issued by the General Manager, Karnataka Vikash Grameena Bank, Dharwad, rwad, Karnataka pursuant to his success in the Examination and Interview held by the Institute of Banking Personnel Selection."
