APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Bikram
P.S. Case No. 370 of 2023 instituted for the offences under
Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, some unknown persons
stopped the tractor of the informant, which was being driven by
his driver thereafter looted away.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the



present case. Petitioner is not named in the FIR and the same has been lodged against unknown persons. Due to high-handedness by the police, the name of the petitioner has come into light. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged occurrence. No incriminating/looted article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. The petitioner is in custody since 28.08.2023 and has three criminal antecedents.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Bikram P.S. Case No. 370 of 2023, Subject to the following conditions:

(i) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(ii) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two



consecutive dates, the trial Court will have liberty to cancel the
bail bonds of the petitioner.
