2 04-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"That, this writ petition is being preferred for setting aside the order-dated 12.01.2023 passed by District Programme Officer, ICDS, Siwan in Appeal Case No. 06/2022-23 Smt. Kumari Seema Yadav Versus Sunita Kumari and others whereby the Appeal was allowed and the appointment of petitioner was directed to be cancelled with immediate



effects indicating the selection of Seema Devi in her place in absence of proper consideration to pleading of parties and arguments advanced therein with supporting documents and further prayer for restoration of proposition/status as earlier before adverse order."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a civil suit before the learned civil court of competent jurisdiction. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
