2. This Court finds that no rejoinder affidavit has been filed

by the petitioner to refute the aforesaid factual aspect of the

matter and moreover, this Court finds that the supplementary

show cause has been sworn by the District Magistrate, Siwan,



hence, this Court has no reason to disbelieve the fact that the encroachment in question has stood removed.

3. In view of the aforesaid, this Court is satisfied that the order of this Court dated 4.11.2022, passed in CWJC No. 194 of 2022, has stood complied with, hence, the present contempt petition stands dismissed.
