2 23-01-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1. That this is an application for issuance of an appropriate writs, orders and directions against the respondents for commanding the respondents to quash the Show Cause notice as contained in Annexure 5. issued by Respondent No. 3 vide Memo No.117 dated 17.02.2022 against the petitioner, whereby and where under the petitioner was directed to file Show-Cause within 3 days before the concerned Authority as to why the Departmental



Proceeding would not be initiated under the Bihar, Government Servant (Classification Control and Appeal) Rules, 2005 against him regarding alleged charges of misappropriation and be pleased to direct the respondents not to take any coercive action against the petitioner during pendency of the writ petition and your Lordships may be pleased to pass any suitable and appropriate order as it deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of this case.”

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent-authorities for redressal of his subsisting grievances, if any. Liberty so sought is granted.

3. The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
