2 04-04-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered
for the offence under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, it is a case of theft of
a tractor bearing Chechis No. N.H.16292858, Engine No.F-
79058 of the informant.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has sub-
mitted that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He
next submits that there is no recovery from the possession of the
petitioner and his name transpired on the basis of some of the
accused in a different case. Petitioner is in custody since
07.01.2024.



5. Learned APP appearing for the State, opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be directed to be released on bail *after framing of the charge* in connection with Masaurhi P.S. Case No.659 of 2022 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, Masaurhi.

7. The trial court is directed to conclude the proceeding of framing of charge according to law within a period of 15 (fifteen) days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. However, it is made clear that *if the charge-sheet has not been submitted* then the above named petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond with further condition that the petitioner have to present physically on each and every date before the Trial Court till conclusion of the proceeding of framing of charge.
