4 22-08-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for the opposite party
no. 2.

2. The petitioner, husband of opposite party no. 2,
apprehends his arrest in a complaint case punishable for the
offence under Sections 498(A), 406/34 of the Indian Penal Code
and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

3. Earlier, the matter was referred to Mediation &
Conciliation Centre of Patna High Court to explore the
possibility of settlement between the parties and the Mediator,
vide its report at flag 'A', has reported that the dispute between
the parties has been resolved amicably through the process of
mediation and both parties have agreed to live separately and



not to interfere in the life of each other. Both sides have also agreed to withdraw their cases, which have been filed against each other. These facts have been mentioned in Memorandum of Agreement attached with Mediator’s report.

4. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances, the anticipatory bail petition of petitioner is allowed.

5. In the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the petitioner, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of **Rs.10,000/-** (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M. (East), Muzaffarpur in connection with Complaint Case No. 530 of 2019 / Tr. No. 2862 of 2020, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure with further condition that *petitioner shall abide by all the terms & conditions, as mentioned in Memorandum of Agreement, failing which, learned Court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail-bond of the petitioner.*
