2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with  
Musrigharari P.S. case No. 160 of 2023 instituted for the  
offences under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that this petitioner was  
caught with a stolen car.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the  
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. No  
incriminating/looted article has been recovered from the  
conscious possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the  
petitioner further submitted that the vehicle in question was  
purchased by the wife of the petitioner from one Ratan Kumar



Paswan and there is no question of theft of the alleged vehicle and in support of his contention, learned counsel referred Annexure-2 of the present bail application. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 07.10.2023 and has four criminal antecedents.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, as also the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Musrigharari P.S. case No. 160 of 2023.
