APP for the state.

2. The instance application for regular bail has been
filed by the petitioner in connection with Ramgarhwa P.S. Case
No. 202 of 2022 instituted for the offence u/s 8, 21(C), 29 of the
N.D.P.S. Act.

3. Earlier the application for regular bail of the
petitioner was rejected by order dated 20.7.2023 passed in Cr.
Misc. No. 555 of 2023 with a direction to expedite and conclude
the trial as soon as possible.

4. In pursuance to the direction of this Court, a report
dt. 2.4.2024 with regard to the present stage of trial has been
received by which it appears that no any witness has been



turned up for examination and trial is likely to be concluded within a period of one year.

5. No fresh ground is made for reconsideration of the regular bail application of the petitioner, as such, his prayer is rejected.

6. Accordingly, the application stands disposed off.

7. However, learned trial court is directed to expedite and conclude the trial within a period of six months, failing which the petitioner may renew his prayer of bail.
