ORAL ORDER

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
has submitted that petitioner has falsely been
d in the present case. It is submitted that recovery of
illicit liquor was not made from conscious physical
n of the petitioner and he has no concern with the



alleged recovery of illicit liquor as well as motorcycles in question. It is submitted that seizure list appears doubtful being not supported by local witnesses as one witness belongs to Supaul and one belongs to Chhattisgarh. It is further submitted that petitioner is in custody since 06.12.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State, opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances and submissions made on behalf of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail, ***after framing of the charge***, in connection with Fulkaha P.S. Case No.181 of 2023 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Court No.2, Araria.

7. The trial court is directed to conclude the proceeding of framing of charge according to law within a period of 15 (fifteen) days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. However, it is made clear that ***if the charge-sheet has not been submitted*** then the above named petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond with further condition that the petitioner have to present physically on each and every



date before the Trial Court till conclusion of the proceeding of framing of charge.
