4      28-06-2024              Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP  
for the State.

2.      The petitioner seeks bail in Rajgir P.S. Case No.  
474 of 2023, instituted for the offences punishable under  
Sections 397, 406, 420, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3.      The prosecution case, in short, is that, two persons  
hired the vehicle of the informant and proceeded towards  
Nalanda. On the way they offered water to the informant and  
after consuming the same, the informant got unconscious. Two  
days later the informant regained his sense and saw that his E-  
Rickshaw, mobile phone and cash of Rs. 400/- was missing.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. Name of the petitioner has been transpired during the course of investigation on the basis of his self-confessional statement. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that Charge-sheet has been submitted in the present case. The petitioner is in custody since 06.12.2023 and has got one criminal antecedent. Other co-accused has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 19-03-2024, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 20392 of 2024.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, charge sheet being submitted and taking into account the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Rajgir P.S. Case No.



474 of 2023.
