The petitioner is before this Court seeking a direction
to the respondents for construction of a road over Khata No. 379
Plot No. 1436, Area 32 decimals situated in Village Biskurwan,
Gram Panchayat- Muraura in the district of Nalanda.

2. It is stated that the respondent-authorities are under
a legal obligation to construct the roads since the land for the
same has been identified and the funds have been sanctioned



under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme.

3. We would not in a Public Interest Litigation monitor the construction of a road, which in any way, falls within the policy domain of the State. We find absolutely no reason to entertain the writ petition and dismiss the same.
