reliefs:-

“1(i). To direct the respondent authority to pay the financial benefits after grant of first and second ACP.

(ii). To further direct to Respondent authority re-fixed the pension of the petitioner after payment of first and second ACP.”

2.      After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Respondent No. 2, i.e. the District Magistrate, Patna, for



redressal of her aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
