ORAL ORDER

5 20-12-2024 The learned counsel for the opposite parties has submitted, by referring to the show cause filed in the present case, that as far as Plot No. 1322 is concerned, the same is



raiyyati land of private persons and as far as Plot No. 1365 is concerned, though the same is a public land, however, there is no encroachment over the same.

2. This Court is satisfied that the order of this Court dated 05.09.2023 passed in CWJC No. 11288 of 2023, has stood complied with.

3. At this juncture, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be granted liberty to agitate his grievances before the concerned State authority, in case any encroachment is prevailing over the public land in question. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

4. The contempt petition stands dismissed.
