2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Shikarpur P.S. Case No.849 of 2023 instituted for the offences under Sections 356, 379, 411, 413, 414 and 34 of the IPC.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that petitioner along with co-accused persons coming by a motorcycle, the informant's mobile was snatched. After that petitioner and co-accused persons was chased by the informant and local public and caught them with stolen mobile and motorcycle. After interrogation they disclosed their names as Afjal Alam and Md. Imran. Accordingly, the FIR.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Further submits that from the FIR it appears that



the stolen mobile was recovered from the co-accused, Md. Imran and after that a production-cum-seizure list was prepared. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 30.10.2023 and has no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposes the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, clean antecedent of the petitioner and period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of court below/concerned court in connection with Shikarpur P.S. Case No.849 of 2023.
