ORAL ORDER

2 22-03-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That the petitioner beseeches indulgence of the Hon'ble High Court with a prayer for issuance of appropriate writ or writs in the nature of Mandamus commanding the respondent authorities particularly the Executive Engineer, PH Division, Public Health Engineering Department, Chhapra to grant promotion to the post of Clerk in Class-III for which he fulfills the



criteria under relevant Rules, and this promotion may be directed to be given from the date when his junior, respondent no. 05 has been granted, i.e., dated 12.12.2023, and denial of the same to this petitioner is arbitrary action on part of the respondent authorities and/or the Hon'ble Court may grant any other relief or reliefs as may be pleased in the facts and circumstances of the case."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Superintending Engineer, PH Circle, PHED, Saran at Chhapra i.e. the respondent no. 3, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. It is needless to state that in case the petitioner approaches the Superintending Engineer, PH Circle, PHED, Saran at Chhapra i.e. the respondent no. 3, by filing appropriate representation, within a period of two weeks from today, the same shall be disposed off by a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with



law, within a period of six weeks, thereafter.

4. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
