2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the



petitioner has submitted that petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. It is submitted that during course of investigation alleged recovery of paddy was made from godown of Santosh Kumar on the basis of disclosure made by co-accused Virendra Chaurasia. It is further submitted that petitioner is in custody since 06.01.2024.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State, opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances and submissions made on behalf of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail, ***after framing of the charge***, in connection with Murliganj P.S. Case No.07 of 2024 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Madhepura.

7. The trial court is directed to conclude the proceeding of framing of charge according to law within a period of 15 (fifteen) days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. However, it is made clear that ***if the charge-sheet has not been submitted*** then the above named petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond with further condition that the petitioner have to present physically on each and every



date before the Trial Court till conclusion of trial and if the petitioner would absent for two consecutive dates without any cogent reason, the bail bonds of the petitioner shall be cancelled by the learned trial court itself.
