ORAL ORDER

2 15-03-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in Rajapakar P.S. case
No. 317 of 2023 instituted for the offences under Sections
414 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Prosecution allegation, in short, is that the police
recovered one black colour motorcycle from the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
the present case merely on the basis of suspicion. No
incriminating material has been recovered from the house of
the petitioner. As per the seizure list, the motorcycle has
been recovered behind the house of the petitioner which is
an open place. The petitioner has got no concern with the



said motorcycle. In fact the petitioner has been arrested in Rajapakar P.S. case No. 53/2023 and on the basis of his confessional statement, which has no evidentiary value, he has been made accused in the present case. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. The petitioner is in custody since 04.09.2023 and has four criminal antecedents in which he is on bail.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Rajapakar P.S. case No. 317 of 2023 subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.



(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
