APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Khanpur P.S. Case No. 312 of 2023 dated 02.12.2023 registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 15 litres of illicit country made liquor was recovered on the roof of the petitioner house.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent. No



incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition of the petitioner and submitted that the alleged recovery has been made from the house of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the view that no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out and the same is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the court below concerned within six weeks from today and pray for regular bail and the learned Court below shall consider the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner on the same day without being prejudiced by this order.

7. The application stands disposed of.
