parties.

2. The petitioner seeks bail registered for the offence
under Sections 413, 414, 467, 468 and 471/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the informant
received a secret information that the shop of one Amir
Motorcycle located on chopda agency road where stolen
motorcycle was selling and buying then the police party reached
there then a person saw the police party started to flee away but
he was apprehended by the police and he disclosed his name as
Md. Javed and some judicial stamps paper have also been
recovered from the said shop and thereafter some motorcycle



have also been recovered from other place.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He next submits that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and he has got clean antecedent as stated in para-3 of the petition and he is in custody since 10.01.2024.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State, opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. On perusal of the first information report, seizure list and impugned order dated 12.02.2024, it appears that the name of the petitioner is the self confessional statement and the petitioner is only an employee of Neha connecting cyber cafe and there was no recovery from the possession of the petitioner, in these circumstances, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be directed to be released on bail in connection with Civil Line P.S. Case No.10 of 2024 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-I, Gaya.
