ORAL ORDER

Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf

of the parties.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Daudnagar Excise P.S. Case No.40 of 2024 registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per FIR, there is recovery of total 5 litre of illicit liquor from possession of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. It is submitted that recovery of alleged illicit liquor was not made from conscious physical possession of the petitioner and he has no concern with the



alleged recovery of illicit liquor. It is submitted that seizure list appears doubtful being not supported by independent witnesses, rather by police personnels. It is further submitted that petitioner is in custody since 14.02.2024.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State, opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances and submissions made on behalf of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail in connection with Daudnagar Excise P.S. Case No.40 of 2024 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise 2nd Aurangabad.
