seeking the following relief:-

*“1.That is an application for  
issuance of the writ in the nature of  
Mandamus or any appropriate  
writ(s), order(s), direction(s) to the  
respondents to transfer the  
petitioner who is A.N.M. presently  
posted at Primary Health Centre,  
Bhitaha, in Bhitaha block in West  
Champaran at Bettiah district from*



*Bhitaha Block to any block of her native district i.e. Samastipur district or its adjoining district."*

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent no. 2 i.e. the Director, Department of Health, Government of Bihar, Patna, for redressal of her aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

It is needless to state that in case the petitioner approaches the respondent no. 2 i.e. the Director, Department of Health, Government of Bihar, Patna, by filing appropriate representation, within a period of two weeks from today, the same shall be disposed off by a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks, thereafter.
