petitioner and Mr. Dilip Kumar No. 1, learned A.P.P. for the

State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Section 302 of the
Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the informant
alleged that the petitioner had killed her husband.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not
specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that
the postmortem report as well as viscera report do not support
the prosecution case, though the informant is eye-witness in the



present case. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the postmortem report as well as viscera report do not support the prosecution case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Ahiyapur P.S. Case No. 1535 of 2023, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
