A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Kotwa P.S.
Case No. 11 of 2020 registered for the offences punishable
under Sections 420, 406 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner has
received Rs.4,00,000/- on 20.03.2018, Rs.3,50,000/- on
22.05.2018 and Rs.4,00,000/- on 29.10.2018 through three
cheques, but he has not completed the work of Nal-Jal Yogna in
Ward No. 09 of Karariya Panchayat.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not



specific rather general and omnibus in nature.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of case and the nature of the offence, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is hereby rejected.

7. However, if the petitioner surrenders before the learned Court below within six weeks from today and seek regular bail, the learned Court below would pass order on the same day in accordance with law without being prejudiced by this order.
