2 10-04-2024 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323,
354B, 379, 504, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has antecedent of one case which was also instituted
by the instant informant but police after investigation submitted
closure report. It is next submitted that petitioner is own uncle
of the informant. It is further submitted that from perusal of the
allegation as alleged in the F.I.R., it would manifest that the
informant concealing the relationship instituted the instant FIR
with an allegation that the petitioner along with his son Atul
acted inappropriately with her and on alarm when some people



came the petitioner fled away after snatching her chain. It is next asserted and submitted that petitioner is own brother of the father of the informant and on account of family dispute, the present false case came to be instituted. It is next submitted that the fact that informant concealing the relationship has instituted the instant FIR which casts an aspersion on the case of the prosecution.

4. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

5. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Daudnagar P.S. Case No. 704 of 2023 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
