2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has filed several representations before the respondent No.3 and the respondent No.3 has not taken any action as yet and the similarly situated persons have been granted the benefit as petitioner demanded by way of writ application.

3. In view of the aforesaid, the present writ application is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to file a detailed representation alongwith supporting documents before the respondent No.3 and the respondent No.3 is directed
