2. Mr. Rakesh Kumar Sharma, learned counsel
appearing on behalf of the petitioner informs that for one reason
or another by filing frivolous petition, the informant side is

3. Mr. Saket Kumar, learned counsel appearing on
behalf of the informant informs that he has advised the
informant that all such applications filed at the stage of
