2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the judgment passed by this Court in L.P.A. No.1254 of 2016 and analogous cases.

3. Considering the aforesaid facts, since the case of the petitioner stand on similar footings to that of the petitioners of L.P.A. No.1254 of 2016, there is no requirement to keep pending the present writ application.

4. Accordingly, petitioner is directed to file a detailed representation along with a copy of the order passed in L.P.A. No.1254 of 2016, before the respondent no.5 within a period of four weeks and the respondent no.5 is well advised to consider the case of the petitioner and dispose of the representation of the petitioner after affording an opportunity of personal hearing or through his counsel and pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law and in light of the order passed in L.P.A. No.1254 of 2016 within ten weeks from the date of filing of such representation by the petitioner.

5. It is made clear that respondent no.5 shall be personally



held responsible for non-compliance of this order.

6. The memo no.856 dated 18.03.2020 issued by the District Education Officer, West Champaran, is hereby quashed and petitioner shall be entitled to get all the consequential benefits.

7. With the aforesaid directions, this writ application stands disposed of.
