APP for the State.

2. This is the second attempt for bail of the petitioner as earlier such prayer was rejected by order dated 30.08.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No.56528 of 2023.

3. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 30(a), 30(d), 30(f), 33, 41, 52 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

4. The petitioner is in jail since 05.04.2021 but remanded in Judicial Custody in this case since 22.12.2022. Earlier the bail application of the petitioner was rejected because of his criminal antecedents. The petitioner submits that he will give an undertaking in the Court below that he will not involve himself in any criminal case after being released on bail.



5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this application is allowed.

6. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Exclusive Special Excise Judge, 1st, Nawada in connection with Nawada (Nagar) P.S. Case No. 602 of 2020.

7. The petitioner after grant of bail will stay at the following address-

8. The petitioner will also mark attendance in Khidipur Babu Bazar, South Port Police Station, Kolkata, Pin-700043 on the first Sunday of each month. Any default in appearance at the Police Station would be result in cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioner.

9. The petitioner will visit Bihar only on the date fixed in the present case as well as in other cases in which he is an accused and is required to visit the Court. Before leaving Bengal the petitioner will inform the local police station about



the case and the date and the period for which he is going to stay
in Bihar to attend the cases
