ORAL ORDER

4 29-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail Brahmpur P. S. Case No.
719 of 2023 registered for the offence punishable under Section
376 of the IPC and Section-4 of the POCSO Act.

3. Allegedly, the petitioner enticed away the minor
daughter of the informant aged about four years and having
taken her to a lonelysome house, committed wrong with her.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is a person of clean antecedent. The petitioner
has falsely been implicated in this case due to village politics
and he is in custody since 08-12-2023.



5. It is a case of heinous crime, in which, a four years minor girl was ravished. In paragraph-6 of the case diary as well as in her statement recorded under Section-164 of the Cr.P.C., the victim has fully supported the case of the prosecution.

6. Considering the gravity and heinous nature of offence, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner and accordingly, it is rejected.
