2. The application has been filed preferring the
following relief :-

*“(i) For issuance of writ/writs
order/orders to for releasing the Khesra No.
506 which has been entered in Registration
stay list Thana No. 155, Khata No. 2, Khesra
No. 506 village Ajagarawa P.S. Pakarideyal.
Said land mention in Register-2 in*

*Jamabandi No. 15 and land area 0.7.1 dhur
