*“1. That, this is an application for
issuance of appropriate writ(s) /
direction(s) for quashing of the Office
Order contained in Akon Letter No.385
dated 07.12.2019 passed and issued
by the Respondent No.-3, whereby and
whereunder the service of the
petitioner made on the post of
Executive Management (General) in
Bodh-Gaya Temple Management
Committee, Bodh-Gaya (in short
BTMC) in District-Gaya has been*



terminated.

Further the respondents be directed to reinstate the petitioner in his service with all service benefit as given in advertisement dated 17.07.2018 (Annexure-1)."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
