3 13-09-2024 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 149, 323, 325, 308, 384, 386 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegedly, all the FIR named accused persons including the petitioner along with 10-15 others are said to have assaulted the father of the informant.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. The specific allegation is against co-accused



Shailendra Paswan and Shabir Khan. There is no specific overt act against the petitioner. He further submitted that similarly situated co-accused has been granted bail by this Court in Cr. Misc. No.22364 of 2024 dated 04.04.2024. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Bahera P.S. Case No.174 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
