- 2 01-05-2024 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned A.P.P. for the State.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset seeks permission to withdraw the anticipatory bail application with respect to petitioner no.2 (Khushbu Yadav @ Nishi Kant Yadav @ Nishant Kumar) and petitioner no.3 (Jaiki Yadav @ Kumar Amit).
3. Permission is accorded.
4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Ishipur Barahat P.S. Case No.131/2023 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 341, 323, 353, 354, 379, 201, 504 and 506 of the



Indian Penal Code. It is next submitted that the investigation in the case is still pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bhagalpur.

5. The learned APP submits that the offences for which the instant F.I.R. has been instituted against the petitioner carries a punishment of less than 7 years to which the learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute.

6. In view of the submission made by the learned APP the anticipatory bail application is disposed of in terms of the order dated 13.02.2024 in Cr. Misc. No.3536/2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. State of Bihar).

7. The petitioner would be at liberty to file a representation within a period of three weeks from today before the concerned Superintendent of Police of the district and the Investigating Officer of the case with a web copy of the order dated 13.02.2024 in Cr. Misc. No.3536/2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. State of Bihar) and the Superintendent of Police shall ensure that Investigating Officer of the case strictly adhere to the direction contained in the said order.
