The instant application for regular bail has been filed by the petitioner in connection with Forbesganj P.S. Case No. 265 of 2023 instituted for the offence punishable under Sections 20 and 22 of N.D.P.S. Act.

Earlier the application for regular bail of the petitioner was rejected by order dated 10.10.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 33891 of 2023 with an observation to learned trial court to expedite the trial and conclude the same as soon as possible.

In pursuance to the direction of this Court, a report, dated 21.03.2024, with regard to present stage of trial has been received and the same is kept at flag 'A'. From its perusal it appears that none charge sheeted witnesses have been examined



till today and the case is at the stage of evidence on behalf of the prosecution. The case is at the stage of evidence on behalf of the prosecution and the trial is likely to be concluded within six months.

No fresh ground is made for reconsideration of the regular bail of the petitioner. Accordingly, prayer for grant of regular bail is rejected.

Accordingly, petition stands disposed off.

However, learned trial court is directed to conclude the trial within stipulated period ie. 6 months., failing which, the petitioner will be at liberty to renew his prayer of bail.
