2 15-05-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief(s):-

*“1.i. To declare the notice impugned contained
in annexure- 4 as illegal, mala fide, capricious
and colourable exercise of power because the
same has been issued without hearing the
petitioner.*

*ii. To issue a writ in the nature of mandamus
for a direction to the respondents authorities to
not disturb the peaceful possession of the
petitioner till the disposal of the case or till the
logical conclusion of the matter.*

*iii. To issue a writ in the nature of mandamus
for a direction to respondent authorities to not
pass any adverse order against the petitioner
till the disposal of the present writ petition.”*



2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Baheri, District-Darbhangha, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
