2. Petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Mahkar P.S. Case No.105 of 2020 dated 19.09.2020, registered
for the offence punishable u/s 363/366 of the IPC, pending in
the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Gaya.

3. After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner
seeks permission to withdraw this application.

4. Permission is granted.

5. Accordingly, the instant application is dismissed as
