"(A) For issuance of a direction, order or writ, to the concerned respondent authorities to quash column 8.3 (b) (ii) of the circular no. 640/2020 dated 16.10.2020 (Annexure-P4) issued by the Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India Limited, A Govt. of India (Ministry of Railways) Enterprise.

(B) For issuance of a direction, order or writ to



the respondent authorities to promote the petitioner from JPM / Civil (E2) to APM / Civil (E3) of the date of promotion of the other similar employees with consequential benefits."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent-authorities for redressal of his aforesaid grievance. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
