- 2 06-05-2024 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned A.P.P. for the State alone with learned counsel for the informant.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners seek anticipatory bail in connection with Beur P.S. Case No. 638 of 2023 for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 341, 379, 448, 504, 506 and 147 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. It is next submitted that investigation in the case is still pending.



4. The learned APP submits that the offence for which the instant FIR has been instituted, carries punishment of less than seven years, the said submission of the learned APP is not disputed by learned counsels appearing on behalf of the petitioners and the OP No. 2.

5. In view of the submission made by the learned APP, the anticipatory bail application is disposed of in terms of the order dated 13-2-2024 passed in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 3536 of 2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. the State of Bihar).

6. The petitioners would be at liberty to file a representation before the concerned Superintendent of Police and the Investigating Officer of the case, within a period of three weeks from today, with a web copy of the order dated 13-2-2024 in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 3536 of 2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. the state of Bihar); and the concerned Superintendent of Police shall ensure that the Investigating Officer of the case strictly adheres to the directions contained in the order dated 13-2-2024 in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 3536 of 2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. the State of Bihar).
