2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in connection with Raxaul P.S.
Case No. 501 of 2023 for the offences punishable under
Sections 401 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. It is next submitted that investigation in the case is
